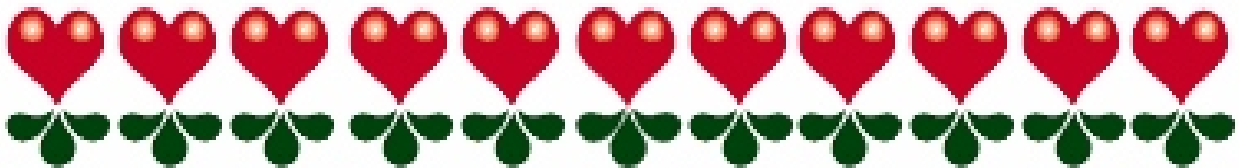

All championship, premiership and registered kittens will be scored for CFA National and Regional awards. Permanent ribbons will be used. This show will be conducted under the current CFA rules. All cats are to be free from fleas, ear mites, infections or any contagious illness. Inoculations for Distemper, Rhino and Calici should be current. Front and back claws must be clipped. Declawed cats may not be entered.
